



Hall of Fame Criteria

Nominations must be submitted in writing no later than March 1st of the current bowling season and the Board of Directors shall vote on the nominee no later than April 4th of the same year.

The Hall of Fame committee shall review all applications and then present the credentials of each nominee, with comments, to the Board of Directors for a vote.

A majority vote of the Board of Directors shall be required to elect a nominee to the Hall of Fame.

The following items shall be considered when proposing a nominee for the Hall of Fame:

- There will be two categories, Bowling Ability and Meritorious Service.
- They must have been a member in good standing for not less than 10 years and not be less than 40 years of age.
- When a nominee has the required number of points necessary for nomination, no further count of points will be necessary.
- The Hall of Fame Committee shall consider all applications every year, but will not select more than 2 nominees in each category.
- All applications shall remain with the Hall of Fame Committee and will be considered each year.
- All scores that carry points must be on a scratch basis.
- Items that apply to bowling ability shall be counted in that category.
- Any person who has or has been suspended by USBC Nationals will have fifty percent (50%) of the required point total deducted from their point total.
- The applicant must have accumulated the required amount of points, four hundred (400), for bowling ability.
- **Meritorious Service will be by written reports, records, and also by individual recommendations.**

Bowling Ability Point System

The point system will allow all bowlers a chance to be inducted into the Hall of Fame. Each achievement will be worth a certain amount of points and when a bowler accumulates 400 points, he/she will earn the chance to be nominated into the Hall of Fame.
